

In 1900 when this Lodge was consecrated, the name of Kildrummie was chosen. There has been speculation as to the origin of the name.

Kildrummie was the fictional name given to Methven Railway station by the one time minister of the Free Church of Scotland, The Rev John Watson, who wrote under the pseudonym of Ian MacLaren.

He was for a number of years Minister at Logiealmond. Kildrummie along with other fictional names was used by MacLaren in his book, 'Beside the Bonnie Briar Bush, (1894).
